Line O Matic records 11 installs of automatic exercise bookmaker

The largest Indian manufacturer of ruling machines, Line O Matic has enjoyed resounding success with its automatic online exercise-book machine. To date, 13 units have been installed, of which 11 are in India.

The company launched the fully automatic online exercise-book machine one year ago. According to Swapnil Patel of Line O Matic: "The new model, with speeds of 250 metres/min, is a big contribution to the positive development of the exercise-book market from 32 pages to 200 pages, including cover."

When we visited Line O Matic's plant in GIDC, close to Ahmedabad airport, we

were suitably impressed with the high-level of engineering and streamlined production. The 80,000 sqft factory houses a production line capable of efficient manufacturing

of exercise books in high volumes. The inline machine, is capable of making exercise notebooks from reel to book. Patel added: "This enables the machine to produce exercise

books in all sizes (including A4 size) – with possible ruling patterns." Line O Matic also manufactures an A4 copier cut-size sheeter and folio-size sheeter.

Line O Matic, formed in 1991, is the leading name in India for exercise notebooks. The company has installed 1,050 machines in India and globally. Of this, it has installed 650 reel to sheet ruling machines, which includes 200 units in Maharashtra.

Line O Matic's clients include Navneet, Sundaram, Wilson and Blue Bird, most of whom have a battery of reel-to-sheet ruling machines, while Mumbai-based Kejriwal Exports boasts 26 such machines.
